3. Must show proof that the students has been accepted and enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution (University, Jr. College, Technical College).
4. Attach an official copy of your high school transcript.

The monetary value of the Chester Lions Club Scholarship will be based upon income generated from various fund-raisers during the fraternal year. The scholarship will be in the amount of no less than \$500.00. Scholarship proceeds will be paid directly to the institution in which the recipient is enrolled.


