The scholarship trust is in the memory of Camille Fieschi Chappuis, a 1981 graduate of Chester High School. Camille was a member of the Chester High Band for four years; the French Club for four years and Dramaddicts his junior year.

The Camille Fieschi Chappuis Memorial Scholarship is a four year renewable scholarship in the sum of no more than \$2500 per academic year. First preference of scholarship award is for an applicant that intends to pursue a course of study in the field of music with the understanding that only one music scholarship be awarded per academic year.

The advisory committee, consisting of the Superintendent, School Board President, and the High School Band Director shall choose from the applicants on the basis of:

- Good Moral Character
- Grades
- Academic Accomplishments
- Strength of Commitment to Obtaining a College Education

The successful applicants must apply annually for an extension of the scholarship fund. Extension guidelines will be given at the time of the original award.
